1. Biological Sculpture: Flowers to Fruit	200	School will create 3-10 ornaments made by students using reused/recycled materials.	October 16
2. Environmental Justice: SDG Goals	200	Students will research the UNSDG Goals and apply them to local issues to develop solutions.	December 11
3. Media: Infomercial	200	Students will create an “infomercial” style video that advertises environmentally friendly alternatives.	January 15
4. Fine Arts and ELA: E-Waste	200	Students will research e-waste common misconceptions and create art depicting different types of e-waste.	February 19
5. Summer Show Sculpture Sustainable Transportation	200	In theme with Cinderella, students will create sculptures representing sustainable forms of public transportation out of “vegetables”.	March 19
