

Materials List – Basic Bow Making Lunch and Learn

Thursday, November 19, Noon – 12:30 pm

First, we will be learning to make a large layered bow that would be suitable for a door wreath or other décor in your home. If you are planning on using this bow outdoors, purchase a ribbon that would be weatherproof and suitable for outdoors. Interior ribbons could be a solid color or print, in your selection of fabric.

Second, we will learn how to make a basic medium sized bow, which could be used for several decorative applications, including gift packaging and interior floral décor. Again, your choice of indoor or outdoor ribbon.

Tools and Supplies needed for both Bows:

A yard stick or tape measure for accurately measuring ribbon

Household Scissors (for cutting ribbon)

Needle nose pliers (for tightening wire)

8 pieces of 12" Chenille stems (Pipe cleaners) **OR** 8 pieces of 12" coated steel wire, either 21 or 22 gauge size

1. Large Bow

You will need: 5 yards of 2 ½" wide ribbon (#40) with wired edges

2. Medium Bow

You will need: 5 yards of 1 ½" wide ribbon (#9) with wired edges
