Basic Drawing Supplies

- Faber-Castell 9000 series pencils – 1 each: 2H, HB, 2B.
Brand does make a difference in smoothness, however, if you have a brand you like, feel free to use.

Additional Supplies – you may have already. Not brand-specific, use what you have, or order if needed.

- White plastic pencil eraser, pencil-shape and/or flat type. Similar to <https://www.dickblick.com/items/21500-0000/>
- Firm, smooth surface, portable drawing board or large clip board that will fit 11" x 14" paper. Similar: <https://www.dickblick.com/items/22945-1007/>
- White Drafting or Blue Painter's tape (any brand is fine)
- 12 or 18 inch Ruler (wood, metal or plastic)
- Pencil sharpener, electric, battery or hand-held or hand-cranke

It is strongly recommended that students purchase Katie Lee's *Fundamental Graphite Techniques* as a reference for Botanical Drawing I (and all your graphite drawing classes).
