This meandering garden features perennials, herbs, ferns, dwarf conifers and fountains.

PALM COURT

SERPENTINE ROOM

Uniquely shaped like a winding snake, this whimsical space changes with the seasons.

SOUTH CONSERVATORY

STOVE ROOM

Bursting with bright tropical blooms, this room houses Butterfly Forest April through early September.

SUNKEN GARDEN

Complete with fountains and hanging baskets, this gorgeous room is always a favorite.

TROPICAL FOREST CONSERVATORY


Journey into the heart of the tropical forest, featuring waterfalls and a serene fish pond.
